COURSE EVENTS

This fast-paced course will move quickly through instructional lectures and demonstrations into practical exercises, then performance exams. You will be working primarily with Adobe software, but will discover additional online tools and resources to add to your digital multimedia toolkit.

ITEMS TO CONSIDER

Students will be provided with a laptop to use for the course. DMC classroom instruction includes training in intermediate-level graphic design and multimedia. It is essential for students to have existing prior knowledge in these areas.

UNIFORM

Students will observe DINFOS policy of wearing the Class B uniform or service equivalent on the last Friday of the month. For prior service students, ensure you bring at least one set of service physical fitness clothes and:

Army students: OCPs and Class B with ribbons (short sleeve shirt)

Air Force students: OCPs and Service Uniform "Blues" (short sleeve shirt)

Navy students: Navy Working Uniform, Navy Service Uniform, and Service Dress Blues or Whites (seasonal dependent – call Navy Detachment if you have questions)

Marine Corps students: Combat Utility Uniform, Service Bravos, Service Charlies and Service Alphas
